EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

OUR VISION AND IMPACT: HISTORY AND MISSION

With the blessings from the Malaysian Government in June 2013, Food Aid Foundation was born. It was challenging because we started from nothing to the construction of Central Kitchen and stores to development of R&D and Quality Control Systems to ensure food safety and hygiene requirements are met before distributing to the communities.

With the commitment of our supportive partners, volunteers, and staff we have served over 865,000 people and families. This success is simply the result of cohesive teamwork of trust and understanding from sponsors and donors to support the vulnerable communities.

Dengan restu daripada Kerajaan Malaysia pada Jun 2013, Food Aid Foundation telah dilahirkan. Ia memang mencabar pada permulaan kerana kami tidak mempunyai apa-apa sejak penubuhan, sehingga pembinaan Dapur Sentral dan stor, serta pembangunan R&D dan Sistem Kawalan Kualiti untuk memastikan keperluan keselamatan dan kebersihan makanan dipenuhi sebelum diedarkan kepada penerima. Dengan komitmen rakan kongsi, para sukarelawan dan kakitangan, kami telah berkhidmat kepada lebih 865,000 orang penerima dan keluarga. Kejayaan ini adalah hasil kerjasama, kepercayaan dan persefahaman daripada penaja dan penderma.

OUR VISION

We will continue this journey until there is ZERO Dependency on the Food Bank and its distributions, in nourishing hope, eradicating hunger and poverty.

EMERGENCY FOOD RELIEF COVID-19

MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO3)

Another lockdown of MCO 3.0 had a huge impact on the B40 and marginalized communities. Many were severely affected financially and emotionally. FAF continued our effort to provide food aid to all communities in need. More than 75,000 food bags were distributed throughout the country.

PKP 3 telah memberi impak yang besar kepada golongan B40 dan masyarakat terpinggir. Ramai yang terjejas dari segi kewangan dan emosi. FAF meneruskan usaha kami untuk menyediakan bantuan makanan kepada komuniti yang memerlukan. Lebih 75,000 beg makanan telah diedarkan ke seluruh negara.

WHITE FLAG INITIATIVES

The #BenderaPutih (White Flag initiative) emerged due to the escalation of Covid-19 positive cases and slowdown in the economy, many local people and organisations stepped up and supported individuals and families in severe need of food and assistance. The initiative, which became popular on social media, urges individuals who are struggling financially to call out for aid without fear or shame by raising a white flag in front of their home as a symbol that they need help right away.

Inisiatif #BenderaPutih muncul berurutan peningkatan kes positif Covid-19 dan kemerosotan ekonomi, ramai orang dan organisasi tempatan memberi dermaan kepada individu dan keluarga yang sangat memerlukan makanan dan bantuan. Inisiatif yang menjadi popular di media sosial ini menggesa individu yang menderita dari segi kewangan untuk meminta bantuan tanpa berasa takut atau malu dengan mengibarkan bendera putih di hadapan rumah mereka sebagai simbol bahawa mereka memerlukan bantuan segera.

PUSAT PEMBERIAN VAKSIN (PPV)

To support the effort of the Ministry of Health in the national vaccination program to all citizens and residents, FAF took the opportunity to provide additional food support for staff and volunteers at various PPV centres, as a token of appreciation for their hard work.

Bagi menyokong usaha Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) dalam program vaksinasi kepada semua warga di Malaysia, FAF menyediakan makanan kepada kakitangan dan sukarelawan di pelbagai pusat PPV sebagai tanda penghargaan.



EMERGENCY FOOD RELIEF FLOOD

During the major flood in December 2021, FAF was able to serve more than 5,800 flood affected families, with the vast majority (85%) of Selangor residents located in Klang, Shah Alam, Hulu Langat and Dengkil/Banting areas. Other states include Pahang, Kelantan, Negeri Sembilan, Melaka and Johor. Essential food bags and dry kitchen supplies, cooked meals, as well as essential items were mobilised to the flood affected areas effectively with prompt assistance from dedicated volunteers and partners.

Semasa banjir besar pada Disember 2021, FAF berkhidmat kepada lebih 5,800 keluarga yang terjejas banjir, dengan sebahagian besar (85%) penduduk Selangor terletak di kawasan Klang, Shah Alam, Hulu Langat dan Dengkil/Banting. Negeri lain termasuk Pahang, Kelantan, Negeri Sembilan, Melaka dan Johor. Beg makanan dan bekalan dapur kering, makanan yang telah dimasak, serta barang keperluan telah diagihkan ke kawasan yang terjejas banjir dengan berkesan dengan bantuan daripada sukarelawan dan rakan kongsi yang berdedikasi.



CSR PROGRAMS

WELFARE/SHELTERED HOME

There are more than 130 welfare and shelter homes registered with FAF. These include homes for vulnerable people from children to people with disabilities and elderly people which have been supported by FAF since its inception. In 2020 and 2021, FAF undertook 60 homes as the homes received less support during the COVID-19 pandemic.

HOMELESS

In partnership with DBKL's Pusat Transit Gelandangan, we serve hot cooked meals to the homeless community through the transit center every week.

SOUP KITCHEN

Donated and rescued surplus food are also shared with community and soup kitchens including the Mustard Seed Soup Kitchen and En Xin Soup Kitchen.

URBAN POOR

Apart from redistributing surplus food, FAF partners with corporate sponsors to supply essential goods, both dry and perishable food to the urban poor communities including PPR and PPRT low-cost housing around Klang Valley. We also distribute essential household products such as baby diapers, adult diapers, milk powder to families and single parents. A community soup kitchen has also been established at PPR Mentari as a pilot project in collaboration with MyPJ.

BREAKFAST PROJECT

FAF works with corporate and communities to provide healthy and nutrient-rich breakfast for children from selected schools in Kuala Lumpur and Negeri Sembilan.

BEYOND FOOD BANK

(a) LABORATORY

FAF has set up a food laboratory to undertake tests on surplus food that has been rescued. This is to ensure food hygiene and safety requirements are adhered to before it is distributed to the beneficiaries and communities, particularly for poultry, beef, and dairy products. The setup of this laboratory was consulted and supported by Taylor's University.

Terdapat lebih daripada 130 rumah kebajikan dan perlindungan telah berdaftar dengan FAF. Ini termasuk rumah untuk orang yang terpinggir seperti kanak-kanak, golongan OKU dan orang-orang tua yang telah diberi bantuan oleh FAF sejak penubuhan. Pada tahun 2020 dan 2021, sebanyak 60 rumah telah diberi bantuan oleh FAF atas kekurangan sokongan semasa pandemik COVID-19.

Dengan kerjasama Pusat Transit Gelandangan DBKL, FAF menyediakan makanan bermasak panas kepada komuniti gelandangan melalui pusat transit pada setiap minggu.

Makanan lebihan yang didermakan dan diselamatkan juga dikongsi dengan dapur jalanan termasuk Mustard Soup Kitchen dan En Xin Soup Kitchen.

Selain daripada pengagihan makanan lebihan, FAF juga bekerjasama dengan penaja korporat untuk membekalkan barang keperluan, makanan kering dan basah kepada masyarakat miskin bandar di perumahan kos rendah PPR dan PPRT di sekitar Lembah Klang. Kami juga mengedarkan barang keperluan rumah seperti lampin bayi, lampin dewasa, susu tepung kepada keluarga dan ibu/bapa tunggal. Dapur komuniti juga telah ditubuhkan di PPR Mentari sebagai projek perintis dengan kerjasama MyPJ.

FAF bekerjasama dengan korporat dan komuniti untuk menyediakan sarapan pagi yang sihat dan berkhasiat untuk kanak-kanak dari sekolah terpilih di Kuala Lumpur dan Negeri Sembilan.


FAF telah menubuhkan makmal ujian makanan untuk menjalankan ujian ke atas makanan lebihan yang telah diselamatkan. Ini adalah untuk memastikan keperluan kebersihan dan keselamatan makanan dipenuhi sebelum diedarkan kepada penerima dan komuniti, terutamanya ayam, daging lembu dan produk tenusu. Pertubuhan makmal ini telah disokong oleh pihak Taylor's University.



(b) COMPOSTING - BLACK SOLDIER FLY FARM

In line with SDG (Sustainable Development Goals) on responsible consumption and production, those inedible surplus food including kitchen waste are sent to Unique Biotech Sdn Bhd, a farm that cultivates Black Soldier Fly (BSF) Larvae which are fed with the organic food waste. BSF larvae is processed as animal feed that is high in protein, and the frass generated by larvae can be converted into organic fertilizer for agriculture and farming.

Selaras dengan SDG (Sustainable Development Goals) mengenai penggunaan dan pengeluaran yang bertanggungjawab, makanan lebihan seperti sisa dapur dihantar ke Unique Biotech Sdn Bhd yang mengusahakan Larva Black Soldier Fly (BSF) dimana sisa makanan organik diberi sebagai makanan. Larva BSF diproses sebagai makanan haiwan yang tinggi kandungan protein dan frass yang dihasilkan oleh larva boleh dijadikan bahan organik untuk pertanian dan tanaman.



(c) SKILLS TRAINING

FAF organizes various F&B skills training to kitchen operators, homemakers and individuals who are involved in food handling and processing, and interested in making F&B as a career or business. FAF F&B Skills Training Programs include: Food Handling Course, Culinary Skills and Baking Skills. The key objective of Skills Training is to empower homemakers and individuals who wish to venture into F&B business or career, and equip them with basic food handling knowledge and skills, culinary and baking skills, as well as entrepreneurship and business management skills so that they could pursue better career paths and enhance livelihoods. For instance, the FAF Baking Classes are specifically designed for single mothers.

Pelbagai latihan kemahiran F&B dianjurkan FAF kepada pengusaha dapur, suri rumah dan individu yang terlibat dalam pengendalian dan pemprosesan makanan, atau yang berminat untuk menjadikan F&B sebagai kerjaya atau perniagaan. Program Latihan Kemahiran F&B FAF termasuk: Kursus Pengendalian Makanan, Kemahiran Kulinari dan Kemahiran Membuat Kek/Roti. Objektif utama adalah untuk memperkasakan suri rumah dan individu yang ingin menceburi perniagaan atau kerjaya F&B, dan memberikan mereka pengetahuan dan kemahiran asas pengendalian makanan, kemahiran masakan dan bakeri, serta kemahiran pengurusan keusahawanan dan perniagaan supaya mereka boleh meneruskan kerjaya yang lebih baik dan meningkatkan pendapatan. Contoh: Kelas Bakeri FAF adalah khusus untuk ibu-ibu tunggal.




Chart 1: Sources of financial support





Chart 2: Expenditure

FOOD COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION



- A meal is equivalent to 350g of food and grocery product as per guidelines of the Foodbank Malaysia Programme administered by KPDNHEP (Ministry of Domestic, Trade and Consumer Affairs).
- Beverages (such as mineral water, juice and cordial drinks) only accounted for 25% of the actual weight for meal conversion.
- RM Value of each meal is calculated at RM5.00 per 350g.




Chart 3: Food source




Chart 4: Types of food




Chart 6: Distribution to beneficiaries

GREEN MARKET PROJECT

In collaboration with Selayang Wholesale Market, Green Market Project was initiated to rescue daily surplus vegetables and redistribute them to the urban poor, especially B40 families living in the Projek Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) flats. In the year 2021, a total 1,167,835 kg surplus vegetables and fruits were distributed to:

FOOD AID FOUNDATION KOTA BHARU BRANCH

The FAF branch in Kota Bharu was established to help the poor, particularly the B40 population that live in remote villages as well as welfare homes. We collect food donations and surplus vegetables and distribute them to areas including Pasir Mas, Tumpat, Tanah Merah and other underserved communities.

Cawangan FAF di Kota Bharu ditubuhkan untuk membantu golongan miskin, khususnya keluarga asnaf/B40 yang tinggal di kawasan kampung serta rumah-rumah kebajikan. Kami mengumpul sumbangan makanan, sayur-sayuran lebihan dan mengagihkannya di kawasan termasuk Pasir Mas, Tumpat, Tanah Merah, dan komuniti yang kurang diberikan bantuan.



GERAK REZEKI MOBILE MEALS

To address the issue of health and malnutrition faced by the B40 families of PPR flats, especially children and elderly people who have limited access to adequate nutrition, FAF has initiated the Gerak Rezeki serving nutritious hot cooked meals to the B40 families since April 2021. A community kitchen was also set up at PPR Desa Mentari where trained cooks and kitchen helpers produce 300 meals once or twice weekly, in which food surplus (especially perishables) are contributed by FAF. Additionally, to ease the distribution of cooked meals between the multiple blocks of flats within the PPR compound, FAF mobilised a food trailer (known as 'Karavan') to serve hot cooked meals for the beneficiaries. In 2021, more than 12,000 hot meals were served under the Gerak Rezeki initiative.

Bagi menangani isu kesihatan dan kekurangan zat makanan yang dihadapi oleh keluarga B40 di PPR, terutamanya kanak-kanak dan warga emas yang kurang memperolehi makanan berkhasiat, FAF telah memulakan Inisiatif Gerak Rezeki yang menyajikan hidangan bermasakan panas yang berkhasiat kepada mereka sejak April 2021. Dapur komuniti juga ditubuhkan di PPR Desa Mentari di mana tukang masak terlatih dan pembantu dapur menghasilkan 300 hidangan sekali atau dua kali seminggu, di mana makanan lebihan (terutamanya sayuran yang mudah rosak) disumbangkan oleh FAF. Selain itu, bagi memudahkan pengagihan makanan bermasak di antara beberapa blok di PPR, FAF mengalihkan triler makanan (dikenali sebagai 'Karavan') untuk menyajikan makanan kepada penerima. Pada tahun 2021, lebih 12,000 hidangan panas telah dihidangkan di bawah inisiatif Gerak Rezeki ini.



FOOD SURPLUS RESCUE

The Food Surplus Rescue Project was established in partnership with supermarkets including Lotus's Malaysia (previously known as Tesco), QRA, and HappyFresh to rescue surplus food and donate it to the disadvantaged, particularly shelter homes and communities in need. In 2021, approximately 316,012 kg were collected and distributed throughout the country.

Projek Penyelamatan Makanan Lebihan telah diadakan dengan kerjasama pasaraya seperti Lotus's Malaysia (dulu dikenali sebagai Tesco), QRA, dan HappyFresh untuk menyelamatkan makanan lebihan dan menderma kepada mereka yang kurang bermasih baik, terutamanya rumah-rumah kebajikan dan komuniti yang memerlukan. Dalam tahun 2021, lebih kurang 316,012 kg akan dikumpulkan dan diagihkan di seluruh negara.



SHOPEE KOTAK KASIH

Together with our strategic partners including NGO and dedicated volunteers around the country, FAF distributed 50,000 boxes of Shopee Kotak Kasih to beneficiaries including OKU (people with disabilities), the orang-asli (indigenous) communities, single parents, urban and rural poor families.

Bersama rakan strategik kami termasuk NGO dan sukarelawan yang berdedikasi di seluruh negara, FAF mengagihkan 50,000 kotak Shopee Kotak Kasih kepada penerima termasuk OKU (orang kurang upaya), masyarakat orang-asli, ibu/bapa tunggal, keluarga miskin bandar dan luar bandar.
