# Executive Summary

## Our Vision and Impact: History and Mission

In June 2013, Food Aid Foundation was born with the blessing of the Malaysian Government.

Over the last decade, we have overcome many challenges from the construction of a central kitchen and stores to development of R&D and quality control systems to ensure food safety and hygiene requirements are met before distributing to the communities.

With the commitment of our supportive partners, volunteers, and staff we have served over 865,000 people and families. This success is simply the result of cohesive teamwork of trust and understanding from sponsors and donors to support vulnerable communities.

Dengan restu daripada Kerajaan Malaysia pada Jun 2013, Food Aid Foundation telah dilahirkan. Ia memang mencabar pada permulaan kerana kami tidak mempunyai apa-apa sejak penubuhan, sehingga pembinaan Dapur Sentral dan stor, serta pembangunan R&D dan Sistem Kawalan Kualiti untuk memastikan keperluan keselamatan dan kebersihan makanan dipenuhi sebelum diedarkan kepada penerima. Dengan komitmen rakan kongsi, para sukarelawan dan kakitangan, kami telah berkhidmat kepada lebih 865,000 orang penerima dan keluarga. Kejayaan ini adalah hasil kerjasama, kepercayaan dan persefahaman daripada penaja dan penderma.

# Emergency Flood Relief



During the monsoon season between November 2022 and January 2023, six states were lashed with heavy rains. Among these states, Sabah, Pahang, Kelantan and Terengganu were hit badly. Some remote villages in Kelantan were flooded more than 3 times between November and December 2022 alone. More than 3,500 families were affected and food aid was mobilised to hardcore poor families in these states.

In July 2022, severe floods hit Baling, Kedah and hundreds of families were affected and provided with essential food aid.



Semasa musim tengkujuh antara November 2022 hingga Januari 2023, enam negeri dilanda hujan lebat. Among these states, Sabah, Pahang, Kelantan and Terengganu were hit badly. Beberapa kampung terpencil di Kelantan mengalami banjir 3 kali antara November dan Disember 2022. Lebih daripada 3,500 keluarga terjejas dan bantuan makanan telah digerakkan kepada keluarga miskin tegar di negeri ini.

Pada Julai 2022, banjir melandai Baling, Kedah dan ratusan keluarga terjejas serta diberikan bantuan makanan.

# Food Rescue



## Welfare and Shelter Homes

More than 75 homes are listed with us. These are homes for vulnerable people from children to people with disabilities to the elderly which FAF have been serving since its inception. FAF undertook to cover another 58 homes due to lesser support during the pandemic.

Terdapat lebih daripada 75 rumah kebajikan dan perlindungan telah berdaftar dengan FAF. Ini termasuk rumah untuk orang yang terpinggir seperti kanak-kanak, golongan OKU dan orang-orang tua yang telah diberi bantuan oleh FAF sejak penubuhan. FAF menambah sebanyak 58 rumah untuk diberikan bantuan atas kekurangan sokongan semasa pandemik.

## Homeless

In partnership with DBKL's Pusat Transit Gelandangan, we serve hot cooked meals to the homeless community through the transit centre every week.

Dengan kerjasama Pusat Transit Gelandangan DBKL, FAF menyediakan makanan bermasak panas kepada komuniti gelandangan melalui pusat transit pada setiap minggu.



## Soup Kitchen

Donated and rescued surplus food is also shared with community and soup kitchens including the Assembly Soup Kitchen and En Xin Soup Kitchen.

Makanan lebihan yang didermakan dan diselamatkan juga dikongsi dengan dapur jalanan termasuk Assembly Soup Kitchen and En Xin Soup Kitchen.



# **Food Rescue**



## **Urban Poor**

Apart from redistributing surplus food, FAF partners with corporate sponsors to supply essential goods, and dry and perishable food to the urban poor communities including PPR and PPRT low-cost housing around Klang Valley. We also distribute essential household products such as baby diapers, adult diapers, and milk powder to families and single parents. A community soup kitchen has also been established at PPR Mentari as a pilot project in collaboration with MyPJ.

Selain daripada pengagihan makanan lebihan, FAF juga bekerjasama dengan penaja korporat untuk membekalkan barang keperluan, makanan kering dan basah kepada masyarakat miskin bandar di perumahan kos rendah PPR dan PPRT di sekitar Lembah Klang. Kami juga mengedarkan barang keperluan rumah seperti lampin bayi, lampin dewasa, susu tepung kepada keluarga dan ibu/bapa tunggal. Dapur komuniti juga telah ditubuhkan di PPR Mentari sebagai projek perintis dengan kerjasama MyPJ.

## **Snacks for school children**

FAF works with corporate partners and communities to distribute share snacks for children from selected schools in Kuala Lumpur and Negeri Sembilan.

FAF bekerjasama dengan korporat dan komuniti untuk menyediakan sarapan pagi yang sihat dan berkhasiat untuk kanak-kanak dari sekolah terpilih di Kuala Lumpur dan Negeri Sembilan.



# Food Rescue



## Food Surplus Rescue Project

The Food Surplus Rescue Project is a partnership program with supermarkets including Lotus's Malaysia (previously known as Tesco), QRA, HappyFresh and PandaMart to rescue surplus food and donate it to the disadvantaged, particularly shelter homes and communities in need.

In 2022, approximately 316,012 KG of surplus food was collected and distributed throughout the country.

Pada tahun 2022, lebih kurang 316,012 KG telah dikumpulkan dan diagihkan di seluruh negara.



# Food Rescue

## Green Market Project

In collaboration with Selayang Wholesale Market, Green Market Project was initiated to rescue daily surplus vegetables and redistribute them to the urban poor, especially B40 families living in the Projek Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) flats. In the year 2022, a total of over 825 tonnes of surplus vegetables and fruit was distributed to:

# Beyond Food Banking



## Food Test Laboratory

FAF has set up a food laboratory to undertake tests on surplus food that has been rescued. This is to ensure that hygiene and safety requirements are adhered to before food, particularly poultry, beef, and dairy products, is distributed to the beneficiaries and communities. The setup of this laboratory was consulted and supported by Taylor's University and Empire Bioscience Sdn Bhd.

FAF telah menubuhkan makmal ujian makanan untuk menjalankan ujian ke atas makanan lebihan yang telah diselamatkan. Ini adalah untuk memastikan keperluan kebersihan dan keselamatan makanan dipenuhi sebelum diedarkan kepada penerima dan komuniti, terutamanya ayam, daging lembu dan produk tenusu. Pertubuhan makmal ini telah disokong oleh pihak Universiti Taylor's dan Empire Bioscience Sdn Bhd.

## Food Waste Composting and Black Soldier Fly Farm

In line with SDG (Sustainable Development Goals) on responsible consumption and production, inedible surplus food including kitchen waste are sent to Unique Biotech Sdn Bhd, a farm that cultivates Black Soldier Fly (BSF) larvae which are fed with the organic food waste. BSF larvae are processed as animal feed that is high in protein, and the frass generated by larvae can be converted into organic fertilizer for agriculture and farming.

Selaras dengan SDG (Sustainable Development Goals) mengenai penggunaan dan pengeluaran yang bertanggungjawab, makanan lebihan seperti sisa dapur dihantar ke Unique Biotech Sdn Bhd yang mengusahakan Larva Black Soldier Fly (BSF) dimana sisa makanan organik diberi sebagai makanan. Larva BSF diproses sebagai makanan haiwan yang tinggi kandungan protein dan frass yang dihasilkan oleh larva boleh dijadikan baja organik untuk pertanian dan tanaman.



# Beyond Food Banking



## Skills Training



FAF organizes various F&B skills training to kitchen operators, homemakers and individuals who are involved in food handling and processing, and interested in making F&B a career or business. FAF F&B Skills Training Programs include: Food Handling Course, Culinary Skills and Baking Skills. The key objective of Skills Training is to empower homemakers and individuals who wish to venture into an F&B business or career, and equip them with basic food handling knowledge and skills, culinary and baking skills, as well as entrepreneurship and business management skills so that they could pursue better career paths and enhance livelihoods. For instance, the FAF Baking Classes are specifically designed for single mothers.

Pelbagai latihan kemahiran F&B dianjurkan FAF kepada pengusaha dapur, suri rumah dan individu yang terlibat dalam pengendalian dan pemprosesan makanan, atau yang berminat untuk menjadikan F&B sebagai kerjaya atau perniagaan. Program Latihan Kemahiran F&B FAF termasuk: Kursus Pengendalian Makanan, Kemahiran Kulinari dan Kemahiran Membuat Kek/Roti. Objektif utama adalah untuk memperkasakan suri rumah dan individu yang ingin menceburi perniagaan atau kerjaya F&B, dan memberikan mereka pengetahuan dan kemahiran asas pengendalian makanan, kemahiran masakan dan bakeri, serta kemahiran pengurusan keusahawanan dan perniagaan supaya mereka boleh meneruskan kerjaya yang lebih baik dan meningkatkan pendapatan. Contoh: Kelas Bakeri FAF adalah khusus untuk ibu-ibu tunggal.





**Chart 2: Expenditure**




# Food Collection & Distribution




- A meal is equivalent to 350g of food and grocery product as per guidelines of the Foodbank Malaysia Programme administered by KPDNHEP (Ministry of Domestic, Trade and Consumer Affairs).
- Beverages (such as mineral water, juice and cordial drinks) only accounted for 25% of the actual weight for meal conversion.
- RM Value of each meal is calculated at RM6.00 per 350g.



# Hotel Food Rescue



This is a food rescue initiative in which surplus or unsold food from hotels is collected and distributed to those in need, such as the homeless or people facing food insecurity. This type of initiative helps reduce food waste and provides nourishment to those who need it. FAF hotel food rescue partners include KLCC Convention Centre, and Double Tree Hilton, Shah Alam.

## Retort Machine KPDNHEP



Retort machines sterilizes food products in sealed containers, such as cans or jars, to extend their shelf life. It uses heat to eliminate harmful microorganisms and can be designed to handle different types of food products. The FAF retort machine, that is sponsored by KPDNHEP, allows us to repack ready-to-eat meals so that food shelf life can be extended.

Mesin retort mensterilkan produk makanan dalam bekas bertutup, seperti tin atau balang, untuk memanjangkan jangka hayatnya. Ia menggunakan haba untuk menghapuskan mikroorganisma berbahaya dan boleh direka bentuk untuk mengendalikan pelbagai jenis produk makanan. Mesin retort ditaja oleh KPDNHEP kepada FAF untuk membungkus semula makanan sedia untuk dimakan supaya jangka hayat makanan dapat dipanjangkan.

# **Embassy of Japan: Grant Assistance**



FAF received the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) awarded by the Japanese Government. This is also the very first international grant that has been obtained by FAF to amplify our outreach effort in cooking and serving nutritious hot meals to the poor, especially those living in the urban poor areas.

# **Star Foundation**

As the recipient of the 2022 Star Social Impact Grant (SSIG), FAF's Gerak-Rezeki F&B Entrepreneurship Program (GFED) aims to equip the marginalised community with culinary and business skills. Apart from the theoretical concepts, participants gain practical exposure to food safety procedures in a commercial kitchen setting.


