Sejarah dan Misi

Food Aid Foundation (FAF) ditubuhkan pada Jun 2013 dengan restu Kerajaan Malaysia. Sejak penubuhannya, FAF telah menjalankan misi untuk menangani isu yang mendesak mengenai ketidakjaminan bekalan makanan di kalangan komuniti kurang berasib baik di Malaysia. Apa yang bermula sebagai inisiatif kecil untuk mengedarkan makanan kepada segelintir individu yang memerlukan telah berkembang menjadi sebuah organisasi yang kukuh dengan dapur pusat di Kuala Lumpur dan tiga dapur satelit di seluruh negara.

Misi kami adalah untuk merapatkan jurang yang dialami oleh individu dan komuniti dengan memastikan perkhidmatan kami lebih responsif dan mudah diakses. Halatuju kami untuk menyelamatkan lebihan makanan dan membasmikan kelaparan dan kemiskinan dengan memastikan hidangan berkhasiat sampai kepada mereka yang memerlukan, terutamanya segmen masyarakat yang rentan seperti kanak-kanak, warga tua, dan orang kurang upaya.

Visi kami adalah untuk mencipta masa depan di mana makanan tidak dibazirkan tetapi digunakan sebagai sumber untuk menyuburkan dan memperkasakan komuniti. Kami membayangkan sebuah dunia di mana setiap orang mempunyai akses kepada makanan yang mencukupi, selamat, dan berkhasiat, tanpa mengira status sosioekonomi mereka. PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Food Aid Foundation (FAF) operates several key programs and initiatives, each designed to address specific aspects of food insecurity and support our mission of eradicating hunger and poverty:

- **Food Surplus Rescue Program:** This initiative focuses on rescuing surplus food from supermarkets, hotels, and food manufacturers. The rescued food is then sorted, repackaged, and distributed to those in need, reducing food waste while providing essential nourishment.
- **Green Market Project:** In collaboration with Selayang Wholesale Market, this project aims to rescue daily surplus vegetables and fruits and redistribute them to urban poor communities, particularly B40 families living in low-cost housing areas.
- **Nutrition Education Programs:** FAF conducts nutrition education sessions for beneficiaries, focusing on healthy eating habits, food safety, and meal planning. These programs empower individuals with the knowledge to make informed dietary choices.
- **Emergency Food Aid:** During natural disasters or crises, FAF mobilizes resources to provide emergency food aid to affected communities. This includes distributing cooked meals and essential food supplies to ensure immediate relief.
- **Skills Training Programs:** FAF organizes F&B skills training for individuals interested in food handling & processing, and entrepreneurship. These programs aim to equip participants with culinary skills, food safety knowledge, and business management insights.
- **Community Soup Kitchens:** FAF supports community soup kitchens that provide hot meals to the homeless and underprivileged. This initiative ensures that vulnerable individuals have access to regular, nutritious meals.
- **Food Banking:** As a food bank, FAF collaborates with various partners to collect, store, and distribute food donations to a network of welfare homes, shelters, and community centers serving diverse demographics.
- **School Healthy Snack Program:** FAF works with corporate partners to provide healthy snacks to children from selected schools, ensuring that students have access to nutritious food that supports their learning and development.
- **Food Waste Composting and Black Soldier Fly Farming:** FAF is involved in sustainable initiatives to convert inedible food waste into compost and animal feed using Black Soldier Fly larvae, promoting environmental sustainability.
- **ESG Initiatives:** FAF integrates Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles into its operations and programs, focusing on sustainable practices, social equity, and ethical governance.

GAMBARAN KESELURUHAN PROGRAM

Food Aid Foundation (FAF) menjalankan beberapa program dan inisiatif utama, setiap satu direka khusus untuk menangani aspek tertentu dalam ketidakstabilan bekalan makanan dan menyokong misi kami untuk membasmi kelaparan dan kemiskinan:

In the year 2023, an impressive total of over 1,051,114.26 kg of surplus vegetables and fruits were distributed, bringing nourishment to numerous households in needs.

Our comprehensive F&B Skills Training includes specialized courses such as Food Handling, Culinary Skills, and Baking Skills. Corporate support from PPB Group Berhad for the "Supermum" initiative and the support of UOB Heartbeat has been instrumental in the success.

As an example, in our collaboration with the Rotary Club of PJ and PPB Group Berhad, our Baking Classes are thoughtfully crafted to cater specifically to single mothers, offering them tailored skills and knowledge to succeed in the culinary world. Through these training programs, we strive to foster empowerment, and skill development, and create meaningful opportunities for personal and professional growth.

Over 65 homes, catering to a range of vulnerable individuals from children to people with disabilities and the elderly, are currently under FAF's care since our establishment. Recognizing the heightened challenges faced during the pandemic, FAF has extended its commitment by including an additional 58 homes under our coverage to address the shortfall in support.

Apart from redistributing surplus food, FAF partners with corporate sponsors to supply essential goods, and dry and perishable food to the urban poor communities including PPR and PPRT low-cost housing around Klang Valley. We also distribute essential household products such as baby diapers, adult diapers, and milk powder to families and single parents. A community soup kitchen has also been established at PPR Mentari as a pilot project in collaboration with MyPJ.

Selain daripada pengagihan makanan lebihan, FAF juga bekerjasama dengan penaja korporat untuk membekalkan barang keperluan, makanan kering dan basah kepada masyarakat miskin bandar di perumahan kos rendah PPR dan PPRT di sekitar Lembah Klang. Dapur komuniti juga telah ditubuhkan di PPR Mentari sebagai projek perintis dengan kerjasama MyPJ.

Food Test Laboratory

Makmal Ujian Makanan

FAF has established a dedicated food laboratory to conduct comprehensive tests on rescued surplus food. This initiative is aimed at guaranteeing strict adherence to hygiene and safety standards before the distribution of food, with a special emphasis on poultry, beef, and dairy products, to beneficiaries and communities.

The establishment of this cutting-edge laboratory was made possible through collaborative consultation and support from esteemed institutions, including Taylor's University and My TEST Lab Sdn Bhd.

FAF telah menubuhkan makmal makanan yang khusus untuk menjalankan ujian menyeluruh ke atas makanan lebihan yang diselamatkan. Food Waste Composting and Black Soldier Fly Farm

Mengompos Sisa Makanan dan Ladang Lalat Askar Hitam

Aligned with the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) on responsible consumption and production, inedible surplus food, including kitchen waste, is forwarded to Unique Biotech Sdn Bhd. This innovative farm specializes in cultivating Black Soldier Fly (BSF) larvae, utilizing organic food waste as their primary source of nutrition. The harvested BSF larvae, rich in protein, are then processed into high-quality animal feed.

Moreover, the frass generated by the larvae serves as a valuable by-product, as it can be converted into organic fertilizer, contributing to sustainable agriculture and farming practices. This circular approach not only minimizes food waste but also promotes a regenerative and eco-friendly system.

Selaras dengan Matlamat Pembangunan Mampan (SDG) mengenai kebertanggungjawaban penggunaan dan pengeluaran makanan, lebihan yang tidak boleh dimakan termasuk sisa dapur dihantar kepada Unique Biotech Sdn Bhd. Ladang inovatif ini khusus dalam pembiakan larva Lalat Askar Hitam (BSF), dengan menggunakan sisa makanan organik sebagai sumber makanan utama mereka. Larva BSF yang dibiakkan, yang kaya dengan protein, kemudian diproses menjadi makanan ternakan berkualiti tinggi.

Selain itu, bahan kumuh yang dihasilkan oleh larva berfungsi sebagai produk sampingan yang berharga, kerana ia boleh diubah menjadi baja organik, menyumbang kepada amalan pertanian dan penanaman yang mampan. ● Green Market Project:

Description: Collaborates with Selayang Wholesale Market to rescue surplus vegetables and fruits and redistribute them to urban poor communities.

Outcomes: Distributed over 1,051,114.26 kg of fresh produce in 2023, improving access to nutritious food for B40 families.

ESG Impact: Promotes environmental sustainability by reducing food waste and supports social equity by providing healthy food to underserved communities.

● Nutrition Education Programs:

Description: Conducts educational sessions on healthy eating, food safety, and meal planning for beneficiaries.

Outcomes: Reached over 2,200 individuals in 2023, empowering them with the knowledge to make healthier food choices.

ESG Impact: Contributes to social well-being by promoting health and nutrition education.

● Emergency Food Aid:

Description: Provides immediate food relief to communities affected by natural disasters or crises.

Outcomes: Mobilized food aid for over 3,500 families affected by floods in 2023.

● Skills Training Programs:

● Program Penyelamatan Lebihan Makanan

Chart 1: Sources of financial support





Chart 2: Expenditure



Carta 3: Sumber makanan





Chart 4: Type of food


